

Solar PV Installer

This individual will perform on-site installation work under the direction of a crew supervisor along with other Dovetail crew members and any subcontractors. Prefer candidates with construction or electrical wiring experience and at least one week of solar PV training. Prior experience installing solar PV systems highly desired.

Prefer an individual based in the central Ohio area. The individual works as a team member of an installation crew installing roof, ground and canopy mounted solar PV systems. Involves mechanical assembly, some foundation work, and DC wiring. Requires physical work outdoors and on sloped roofs. Quality and attention to detail is important, as is safety of on-site installation work. Follows safety procedures specified by crew leader and Dovetail's Safety Manager and ensures safety standards are executed at all times. Occasional site visit survey and sales assistance work will be necessary. Candidate must have good interpersonal skills and the ability to work well with people, organize tasks, resolve issues, and manage multiple activities. Ability to pass an annual drug test is required. The position requires competence working with construction tools, mechanical assembly or carpentry experience and some electrical, as well as the ability to read plans and to navigate section 690 of the NEC manual. Must be competent in the operation of a personal computer and MS Office tools. Overnight travel is required.

Responsibilities:

- Monitors published installation schedule and reports to assigned job sites on time and with proper tools, appropriate dress, and safety equipment.
- Works on installation of assigned solar photovoltaic construction projects under direction of the crew leader and project manager.
- Confirms correct materials and equipment arrive on site.
- Effectively applies our installation procedures, methodology, manufacturer directions, and project standards.
- Minimizes our exposure and risk on project.
- Understands and implements company and project safety procedures.

- Tracks and reports hours worked.
- Occasionally assists with pre-construction site visits, system commissioning, and service calls.
- Submits expense receipts to Office Manager in a timely and accurate manner.
- Loads and unloads tools and materials at job site.
- Participates in project reviews, process improvements and implements quality assurance procedures.
